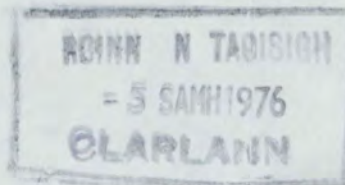


Dear Sir,
