## Note

The Minister spoke to Secretary of State Prior along the lines of the attached note. The Secretary of State said he was not aware whether the E4 unit had yet been stood down. He undertook to examine the possibility of having it stood down, if possible, in the event that it is still in existence. He told the Minister he is outraged by the Judge's remarks but can do nothing about Gibson. He said he thought Hume was doing very badly in the Election.
