We wrote a book, "The Birmingham Framework", to indicate the innocence of the 6 Irishmen sentenced to life imprisonment for the murder of 21 people in Birmingham in 1974. We are sure of their innocence for various reasons. They are poor, ill and come from underpriviliged backgrounds, we are acting at the request of relations.

We are pushing this case in Holland, Germany and the USA.

Hamilton Fish a US congressman of influence is prepared to take up the case and push it for us. We are informed that he received a letter from the Irish Ambassador to Washington, Sean Donlon, trying to put him off this by sending him cuttings from the Irish Times and from the Gutter press of England about Fr. Murray's remarks at the funeral in Armagh of Tony McClelland (R.I.P.) which were fully in accord with the liturgy of the Funeral Mass and rite. If this letter was sent with the cuttings why did it happen? Why this strange course of action? Is the Ambassador becoming part of the Birmingham Framework to keep innocent men in jail in England? Why is he aiding a gross attempt to slander the character of Fr. Murray?
