1. In pursuance of section 29(3) of the Broadcasting Act 1981, I hereby require the Independent Broadcasting Authority to refrain from broadcasting any matter which consists of or includes -

any words spoken, whether in the course of an interview or discussion or otherwise, by a person who appears or is heard on the programme in which the matter is broadcast where -

- (e) the person speaking the words represents or purports to represent an organization specified in paragraph 2 below, or

 (b) the words support or solicit or invite support for such an organization, other than any matter specified in paragraph 3 below.
- 2. The organizations referred to in paragraph 1 above are -
 - (a) any organization which is for the time being a proscribed organization for the purposes of the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1984 or the Morthern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1976; and
 - (b) Sinn Fein, Republican Sinn Fein and the Ulster Defence Association.



- The Batter excluded from paragraph 1 above is any words spoken -
 - (a) in the course of proceedings in Parliament, or (b) by or in support of a candidate at a parliamentary, European Farliamentary or local election pending that election.
