REF. CONVERSATION WITH O HUIGINN RE TERMS OF REFERENCE OF STEVENS INQUIRY. THE PRECISE TERMS OF REFERENCE ARE BETWEEN THE CHIEF CONSTABLE AND MR. STEVENS. HOWEVER, THE BRITISH SIDE, WHILE REQUESTING CONFIDENTIALITY, TOLD ME THAT STEVENS WAS ASKED TO REPORT ON

- (A) THE DISAPPEARANCE OF DOCUMENTS FROM A BELFAST POLICE STATION (DUMMURRAY) AND HIS INQUIPY WOULD EMBRACE THE THEN CURRENT CRUC). INVESTIGATIONS BEING UNDERTAKEN, (I) FOLLOWING ALLEGATIONS IN THE MEDIA ABOUT THE MISHANDLING OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION BY THE SECURITY FORCES (MCGINN MURDER) AND (II) THE DISAPPAPANCE OF DOCUMENTS FROM BALLYKINLAR CAMP.
- (B) ANY OTHER MATTERS RELEVANT TO THIS AREA OF INQUIRY.

WHILE STEVENS HAS NOT BEEN ASKED TO MAKE ''RECOMMENDATIONS''
SPECIFICALLY, IT IS EXPECTED THAT HE WILL DO SO RATHER THAN LEAVE IT
SIMPLY AT PASSING RELEVANT INFORMATION TO THE DPP FOR CRIMINAL
PROSECUTIONS. IT IS FELT THAT THE INVITATION TO LOOK AT ''MATTERS
RELEVANT TO THIS AREA OF INGUIRY'' WOULD LEAD STEVENS TO MAKE
RECOMMENDATIONS. IT WOULD BE A MATTER FOR THE CHIEF CONSTABLE WHAT
TO DO ABOUT SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS.
