

IN CONNECTION WITH ABOVE I WISH TO INFORM YOU THAT THESE CEREMONIES TOOK PLACE ON THE 30TH JUNE 1990 WITHOUT INCIDENT.

APPROX. 500 MEMBERS OF THE LOYAL ORANGE INSTITUTION WERE ESCORTED BY THE GARDAI FROM THE BORDER TO OLDBRIDGE IN NINE (3) BUSES AND ONE (1) MINIBUS. THEY ARRIVED AT OLDBRIDGE AT 1.50PM AND DEPARTED AT 4.00PM. CROSSING THE BORDER AT 5.05PM.
