



## STATEMENT OF INTENT

by the Leadership of the Ulster Resistance

Being satisfied that should the Anglo/Irish Agreement and the ongoing Republican conspiracy not be destroyed they will assuredly destroy our Protestant and British Heritage, we have resolved to band together to take whatever steps are necessary to secure their destruction. To this end the "Ulster Resistance" is pledged to mobilise the men of Ulster into an organised and disciplined force which will neither bend nor budge in pursuit of this unclterable goal.

The "Ulster Resistance" will therefore embark upon a Provincewide recruitment of men willing and prepared to take direct action as and when required. Such action will be strictly disciplined, calculated and controlled.

We are mindful of the serious course we set ourselves but like our fathers in their day of imminent calamity we can do no other. We are not revolutionists or anarchists or murderers. We seek no fight with the forces of the Crown. Our cause is Ulster, the land of our birth. We make it clear to the British and Irish Governments that Ulster Protestants will not sit idly by while our future, teritage and freedom are taken from us. No earthly power has the right to take from us our God-given heritage. Neither hove we the right to surrender it.

We call on the men of Ulster to rally to the cause and to swell our rapks. Our cause is just. Let us with God's help match its justice with our courage and resolution.


