This letter/from W J Mullan is important in that it shows how little intention the loyalists have of carrying their hunger strike to any serious lengths there is 'no way we are going to die' and we 'hope to get it over with by Christmas'. The letter was apparently intercepted on a visit being taken by Prisoner Dodds (another future hunger striker). W J Mullan appears to be the leader of the Loyalist hunger strikers and today informed the Governor that the following prisoners would be going on the strike tomorrow:-
