MY TELEGRAM NO 1805: NORTHERN IRELAND: VISIT OF THE FRIENDS OF IRELAND

1. ONE OTHER PERSON HAS NOW BEEN ADDED TO THE FRIENDS OF IRELAND DELEGATION WHOSE COMPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

THE HON THOMAS S FOLEY (D WASHINGTON) (HOUSE MAJORITY WHIP) THE HON CHARLES F DOUGHERTY (R PENNSYLVANIA) THE HON JAMES N SHANNON (D MASSACHUSETTS) MR KIRK O'DONNELL (GENERAL COUNSEL TO SPEAKER TIP O'NEILL) MR JAMES R FERGUSON (ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO SPEAKER O'NEILL) MR WERNER BRANDT (ASSISTANT TO CONGRESSMAN FOLEY) MR TOBIAS (TOBY) SEGGERMAN (LEGISLATIVE ASSISTANT TO SENATOR DODD)

- 2. THE GROUP WILL TRANSIT LONDON ON THEIR WAY TO DUBLIN ON THE MORNING OF 28 MAY (ARRIVING AT HEATHROW ON PANAM 106 AT 0725 AND DEPARTING FOR DUBLIN AT Ø925 ON AIR LINGUS 153). IF IT WERE POSSIBLE TO HELP THEM IN TRANSIT BY SPEEDING UP FORMALITIES, THIS WOULD BE VERY WELCOME.
- 3. THE ADDITIONAL MEMBER OF THE GROUP (FERGUSON) IS BASED IN BOSTON AND IS O'NEILL'S LINK WITH THE IRISH COMMUNITY THERE. THE OTHER THREE STAFF AIDES ARE CLOSE CONTACTS OF OURS AND WELL-DISPOSED. O'DONNELL ATTENDED LAST YEAR'S DITCHLEY MEETING ON IRELAND. WERNER BRANDT (A FORMER STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICER) IS PARTICULARLY HELPFUL AND WE SUGGEST THAT THE NIO TURN TO HIM IF ANY SNAGS ARISE.

4. THE FOLLOWING ARE BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES ON THE CONGRESSIONAL MEMBERS

OF THE DELEGATION: (A) TOM FOLEY AGRED 53. A CATHOLIC IRISH-AMERICAN WITH A SIZEABLE IRISH AMERICAN ELEMENT IN HIS CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT. FOLEY HAS BEEN IN CONGRESS SINCE 1964, WHEN HE CAPTURED WHAT HAD HITHERTO BEEN A REPUBLICAN DISTRICT. BECAUSE OF ITS DISTANCE FROM WASHINGTON DC (3000 MILES) FOLEY DID NOT CULTIVATE HIS CONSTITUENTS AS ASSIDUOUSLY AS SOME OF HIS COLLEAGUES AND WAS FACED WITH AN UPHILL BATTLE TO KEEP THE SEAT IN 1980. HE HAS SINCE WORKED HARD AT THE DISTRICT, RETURNING

FOLEY WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE UNTIL 1981 WHEN HE GAVE UP THE CHAIRMANSHIP TO BECOME HOUSE MAJORITY WHIP. ALTHOUGH PARTY DISCIPLINE IS SLACK AND CONGRESSIONAL WHIPS DO NOT ,
HAVE THE AUTHORITY OF WHIPS IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS, FOLEY IS ONE
OF THE LEADERS IN THE HOUSE, WIDELY REGARDED AS A POSSIBLE SUCCESSOR TO TIP O'NEILL SHOULD O'NEILL STAND DOWN AS SPEAKER IN TWO YEARS TIME.

THERE EVERY WEEKEND.

FOLEY KNOWS THE UK, INCLUDING NORTHERN IRELAND, WELL AND HAS BEEN A LEADING MODERATE INFLUENCE IN THE FRIENDS OF IRELAND. IT WAS AT HIS INSISTENCE THAT THE FRIENDS OF IRELAND INCLUDED IN THEIR LAST TWO ST PATRICK'S DAY STATEMENTS THE SENTIMENT THAT IRISH UNITY COULD ONLY COME ABOUT BY CONSENT. HE HAS ALWAYS KEPT AN OPEN DOOR TO VISITORS FROM NORTHERN IRELAND, INCLUDING THE DUP DELEGATION WHO WERE HERE IN JANUARY AND WHOM OTHERS IN CONGRESS REFUSED TO SEE. HIS OVERALL APPROACH IS REASONED AND OBJECTIVE AND HE HAS ALWAYS BEEN CONCERNED TO AVOID POSITIONS WHICH COULD SUGGEST THAT CONGRESS WAS INTERFERING IN UK. INTERNAL AFFAIRS.

(B) CHARLES DOUGHERTY.
AGED 44. FIRST ELECTED TO CONGRESS IN 1978, DOUGHERTY, A FORMER
MEMBER OF THE MARINE CORPS AND SUBSEQUENTLY A TEACHER, HAS BEEN
COMBATIVE IN THE HOUSE, OFTEN LINING UP WITH DEMOCRATS. HE HAS ALSO
COMBATIVE IN THE HOUSE, OFTEN LINING UP WITH DEMOCRATS. HE HAS ALSO

GROUP CONSTANTLY AT HIS HEELS. HIS LIFE WAS THREATENED DURING THE
HUNGER STRIKE WHEN, ALONE AMONG LOCAL POLITICIANS, HE REFUSED TO
TAKE PART IN HUNGER STRIKE MARCHES. AT THE SAME TIME HE WAS
VOCIFEROUSLY CRITICAL OF BRITAIN, MAINTAINING THAT UNLESS THE
