A number of other divisions and departments are, however, involved: in addition to DOE (NI), PAB may be able to provide the political background to the resolution and ESL might/to comment on the aconomic consequences of dissolving the Society; there might also be some educational implications since the Society runs a school. In view of the wide number of interests involved, I wonder whether this is a subject suitable for a co-ordinated reply by Contral Secretariat; if you agree, I will forward the folder to you. Whoever is responsible for the final reply, it would seem inappropriate for it to issue before the council elections: the resolution seems something of an electoral stunt.
