RESOLUTION OF LISBURN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Town Clerk of Lisburn Borough Council has written to the private secretary asking him to bring to the attention of the Secretary of State a resolution of the Council condemning recent remarks made by Cardinal O'Fiaich in the Catholic newspaper "The Universe".

## Background

The July issue of "The Universe" contained an interview with Cardinal O'Fiaich which provoked considerable media interest and was roundly condemned by both Protestant church leaders and a number of unionist politicians. Briefly, the Cardinal sought to explain the electoral support achieved by Sinn Fein as being the result of Catholic alienation rather than any conscious support for the use of violence. He argued that the IRA campaign would only end when the problem of alienation was overcome. He said that British policy towards Northern Ireland was "no policy at all" and claimed that the "only ultimate solution" would involve British disengagement. Finally, in what was widely seen as an apologia for the men of violence, the Cardinal said that the IRA did not kill Protestants because of their religion: rather they killed members of the RUC, UDR and so on and the fact that they were Protestants was entirely coincidental.

## Recommendation

The Cardinal's remarks were, of course, misguided and provocative. It is little wonder that unionists of all shades of opinion were incensed and that his views have been quoted as evidence of the intransigence of the Catholic Church and its adherents. would be no advantage in the Secretary of State becoming involved in the controversy and I therefore attach a draft reply which merely confirms the fact that the council resolution has been brought to his attention.
