MACBRIDE CAMPAIGN - COMPANY EMPLOYMENT PROFILES

You asked me to let you have a copy of our material on the religious composition of the workforces of the US companies operating in Northern Ireland. A copy of this material is attached.

As I indicated to you in our telephone conversation, this material is extremely sensitive and I am releasing it to you on a strictly confidential basis. Under no circumstances should it be released to any other party without prior clearance from us.

The companies have provided this information to us on the strict understanding that we will keep it within a small circle on a strict 'need to know' basis. The companies' concern stem from two major factors. The first is that they have no wish to draw any unwelcome attention to themselves in advance of the formal requirement on all companies in Northern Ireland to monitor the composition of their workforces - and it is clear from the attention focused on Ford by Father McManus and the INC that broad arithmetical similarity between the composition of a workforce and the demographic characteristics of its catchment area is no defence against MacBride pressure. The second is that the companies, by and large, have not informed their workforces that they have made this assessment of the religious composition and it would clearly be very damaging to industrial relations if the figures were to leak out.

Maile it is only possible therefore to make use of a few of the figures - ie those which are already in the public domain - you might find it helpful to be aware of the public line we have used in an attempt to draw fire away from the US companies. It is based on remarks made by the Chairman of the FEA and is as follows: -

"The major problems of inequality are not generally connected with manufacturing companies set up by outside investors in the last few decades and, in particular, American companies have on the whole a good record. The Fair Employment Agency receives very few complaints about general patterns of inequality involving American companies, and indeed the majority of complaints are from leaders of the Protestant community, who consider that some of the American companies employ too few Protestants. The extent to which existing American companies can bring about further improvements in the position of Catholics in Norther Ireland is minimal."

I hope you will find this information helpful and I would be happy to expand on or clarify any aspects of it. Indeed, if you or any of your colleagues would like to have a more detailed briefing on the MacBride issue I would be happy to offer it.
