## DAY OF ACTION

- 1. Your minute of 18 August refers.
- 2. The final attendance statistics which I notified to you on 13 August 1986 have been amended slightly with the attached table showing the revised position.
- The main change is in the DOE Industrial figures where the figure for "strikers" is now 1049 and the figure for "absentees" is now 448. PANI have also now accepted a further 59 explanations which makes their figure for "strikers" 118 and for "absentees" 206.
- 4. This now means that 5.5% of the workforce were recorded as "strikers" and a further 8.4% were recorded as "absentees". Taking both together, 13.9% of the workforce was absent on the Day of Action.
- DANI and DOE have not considered it necessary to issue any reminders to their workforces about their obligations as public servants. They have suggested that the issue of any such reminders could be counter-productive and would probably have repercussions especially if it were aimed at only two Departments, even allowing for the fact that the staff of these Departments were the biggest "offenders".
- 6. Of the 1656 people recorded as "strikers":
  - (a) 1648 had a day's pay deducted; 8 were paid for the hours worked before going on strike; the day did not, therefore, reckon towards seniority, additional annual leave, superannuation etc; and
  - (b) 1656 received a written reprimand; 1 officer in PANI would have been subject to further disciplinary action, but resigned before any was taken.

I remain concerned at the DOE Water Service position because of its potential for disruption of service to the community but am not clear what contingency planning DOE has made or can make!
