# Newspaper article on murders 'found in suspect's wallet'

#### What are these?

A newspaper article on the murders of Portadown teenagers Andrew Robb and David McIlwaine was found in the wallet of the 28-year old man standing trial for the double murder, a court was told yesterday.

Steven Leslie Brown, who is also known as Steven Revels, is being tried at Belfast Crown Court where he faces charges of murdering Andrew (19) and 18-year old David.

The pair were taken from a house in Tandragee to an isolated country road on the outskirts of the Co Armagh town in the early hours of February 19, 2000.

Both suffered multiple stab wounds and had their throats slit.

Brown, from Castle Place in Castlecaulfield, denies both charges.

Giving evidence earlier yesterday, a reserve police constable told the court that a house in Coalisland where Brown had been staying was searched by PSNI officers in November 2005.

Among a number of items examined by police after the search was a wallet that contained a newspaper cutting entitled 'Murder charge dropped' which related to the deaths of Andrew and David.

Constable Russell Grant told the court that as well as the folded newspaper cutting, an identification card and a bank receipt belonging to Brown were also found in the wallet.

Another police officer said that when Brown was arrested for the murders of Andrew and David on November 5, 2005, and the charges were put to him, he made no reply.
