BRADLEY: THE TRUTH MEANS THE WHOLE TRUTH

SDLP MLA for Newry and Armagh Dominic Bradley has said that he supports calls for the truth about collusion but he said the truth must mean the whole truth. Speaking on the issue today Mr Bradley said,

"I fully support the call for the truth about collusion between the British state and Loyalist paramilitaries. I want to see the shameful collusion which lay behind the attacks on Reaveys, the O' Dowds, on Donnelly's, Kay's Tavern, on the Rock Bar, on Dublin and Monaghan and the murder of numerous other individuals fully exposed.

"However, Sinn Féin's record in this area leaves a lot to be desired. After all Sinn Féin supported the introduction of the 'On-the-Runs' legislation which would have given immunity to British State killers in return for immunity for the On-the-Runs - Conor Murphy even travelled over to Westminster to welcome the legislation. Sinn Féin only withdrew support for this legislation after a campaign against it was waged by the SDLP.

"But I want to see the whole truth exposed - I want to see the activities of British agent Stakeknife and all the others who also acted as interrogator, judge, jury, and executioner on numerous victims fully exposed. I want to see those who spirited away the Disappeared to murder them without a trace exposed.

"The call for justice can know no bounds, neither sectarian nor political. All relatives - the Reaveys, the O' Dowds, the Kingsmills relatives, and all other victims' relatives - equally deserve the truth, and all calls for justice must include all who suffered injustice regardless of their background."
