SDLP Newry and Armagh Assembly Member Dominic Bradley has said that if the those responsible for the killing Sappers Mark Quinsey, Patrick Azimkar, and Constable Stephen Carroll are traitors who must be turned over to the police then the same logic must be applied to those who were involved in the murder of Paul Quinn and the subsequent cover-up.

Mr Bradley said: "Martin Mc Guinness, Gerry Adams and Conor Murphy must be consistent in their approach to murder and call publicly on those with information about the members of the IRA and all others who were involved in Paul Quinn's murder to pass that information on to the police.

"There can be no further equivocation or no double standards on murder, regardless of who was involved or when it happened.

"Past murders are just as immoral as present murders; there is no line in the sand which divides them, or no qualifications which justifies them. Sinn Féin leaders must speak out and say clearly in public that those IRA members who murdered Paul Quinn are also traitors and murders.

"The murderers of Paul Quinn sought to usurp the role of the PSNI and the Garda Síochána in the community when they said that they were the bosses South Armagh.

"Sinn Fein leaders need to make it clear that those who seek to set themselves up as the bosses or as policeman, judge, jury, and executioner are as treacherous as those who set out to murder policemen or soldiers."
