Speaking on the 33rd anniversary of the Dublin Monaghan Bombings Sinn Fein MEP Mary Lou McDonald has reiterated her party's call for an Irish British summit on collusion. Ms. McDonald said if in Government after the general election Sinn Féin would immediately

initiate a Dáil debate on collusion and make a demand on the British Government for it to participate in a joint summit on collusion.

Ms. McDonald said, "The outgoing Fianna Fáil/PD Government promised a Dáil debate on collusion in the immediate aftermath of the publication of the McEntee report on the Dublin/ Monaghan Bombings. That was another promise which failed to materialise.

"Sinn Féin met with many of the families affected by the tragedy 33 years ago today at a special conference here in Dublin in February. It is clear from that conference that hurt felt by those families is as strong today as ever and is driving and will continue to drive their campaign to find the truth surrounding the circumstances that took the lives of their loved ones.

"If in Government after the election Sinn Féin will immediately initiate a Dáil debate on collusion and will make a demand on the British Government for it to participate in a joint summit on collusion.
